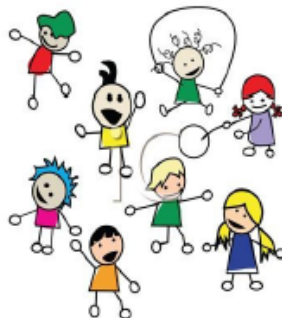

WINTER WEATHER AWARENESS

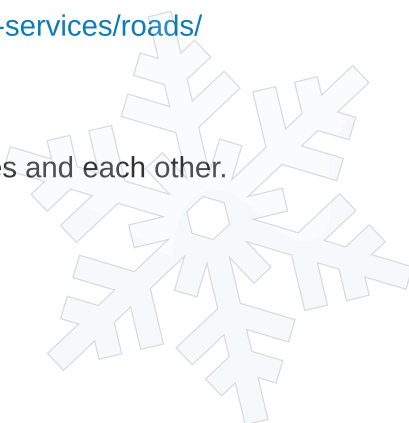
During the winter months we can experience all kinds of weather in this area like rain, wind and sometimes even snow.
